

Animals of the World: Fish

CATFISH



If you are a lover of fish and cats, you are in luck today because I present to you the catfish. It is a popular fish in aquariums and can be found in fresh and shallow waters all over the world, except Antarctica.

It is fascinating to see how its tentacles come out of the mouth, which resemble the long and thin whiskers of cats. These tentacles are called filamentous barbels and are used as a sensory organ. Thanks to them, they can find the food they need to feed themselves.





Their diet is different depending on the species of catfish. Some eat only algae or other plants, while others prefer small invertebrates or other species of fish. It is interesting to see the variety of foods they eat, even though they are all catfish.

There are many different types of catfish. In fact, it is estimated that there are more than two thousand species of catfish. Depending on the species, its body may have spines on the pectoral and dorsal fins. These are used to defend themselves in case of an

attack by a predator. Most species have a hard skin, which they use as a shield against attacks from other animals. Likewise, the colors of the catfish vary. Some catfish species have brown and dark tones, while others have white and bright grayish colors. In Thailand, there is even a species of bumblebee catfish with brightly striped colors, as if it were a sea bee.

Catfish are widely used in aquariums because they help keep them clean. With their "whiskers," they find the leftover food deposited on the walls and bottom of the aquariums and eat it, preventing the remains from clouding the water quality. Some species also eat different types of algae. So, if there is an algae infestation, catfish can eat it, cleaning the aquarium efficiently without using chemicals.





Before you start caring for a catfish in an aquarium, study its habits and way of life. Generally, all catfish enjoy an aquarium with a bottom full of logs, rocks, and caves to hide in. Furthermore, you should know what kind of food the catfish you want likes to eat and if they prefer a dark or light environment. It is also

necessary to know what other types of fish they like to live with or if they would be predators to the other fish in the aquarium. Regarding the cleanliness and oxygenation of the water, it must be measured, filtered, and controlled continuously so that the habitat is optimal for its survival. Finally, before keeping a catfish as a pet, you should think about the aquarium space because the size of a catfish varies from species to species.

Most catfish are nocturnal, although there are some species that are diurnal. It is important to remember this because it will be at night when they get more active and swim through the water.

Now that you know a little more about the life and care of the catfish, would you have one as a pet? Or would you rather have it for dinner?
