6. James cut a peach into 6 slices. If he cuts another peach into 6 more slices, how many slices will he have?



7. Karen writes in her journal everyday. If she writes 5 pages in the morning and 8 at night, how many pages has she written?



8. Joseph folded his laundry. He folded 7 shirts and 4 pants, how many clothes did he fold?



9. Helen swam in her pool. She swam 10 laps forwards and 10 laps backwards. How many laps did she swim altogether?



10. Mark is at a zoo. He fed 2 elephants, 1 camel, 4 monkeys and 3 goats? How many animals did he feed?
