4. Robin is washing dishes. She washed 5 bowls and 9 plates, how many dishes has washed?



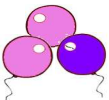
5. Kevin made omelets. He used 3 eggs to prepare each omelet. He made 2 omelets. How many eggs did he use?
