4. Joey ordered 9 pizzas for a party. At the party 7 pizzas were eaten. How many pizzas are there left?



5. Lindsay is grading papers. There are 22 papers and she has graded 18 of them. How many are left to grade?



6. Joseph is at the zoo. There are 28 parrots in the aviary. He only sees 15. How many parrots has he not seen?



7. Janie wants to read 13 books this month. She has read 7 books already. How many more books does she need to read?



8. Andy is playing a video game and needs 20 points to win. He has 12 points now. How many more points does he need to win?



9. Davis has a collection of 28 toys. He gave away 7 of his toys. How many toys does he have left?



10. Valeri has 25 different colored strings for making bracelets. If she uses 6 of them, how many will she have left?
