

Touring Costa Rica

I've been thinking about going to another country for some time, but I couldn't decide which one. Did you know that there are almost 200 countries in the world? San José, the capital, has many large buildings, parks, and monuments. The language they speak is Spanish, so we will have no problem understanding each other. The slogan of the country, Pura Vida, means pure life which describes the spirit of Costa Rica.



The climate in Costa Rica is tropical. There are two main seasons, the dry season is summer, and the rainy season is winter. The weather is mild, so there are no major changes from one season and another. That makes the choice of clothing and footwear much simpler.

It is amazing to observe all the animals it has. Its national bird, called yiguirro. Because of its powerful and melodious singing, many writers mention it in stories and national poems. It is a medium-sized, clay-colored thrush with a yellowish beak. The yiguirro's diet consists of seeds, fruits, worms, and insects.

The inhabitants of Costa Rica work in two main sectors, agriculture or tourism. Costa Ricans grow mostly pineapple, coffee, and bananas among others.

Because of the number of tourists visiting Costa Rica, ecotourism is crucial. Ecotourism seeks to reduce the environmental impact, to take care of the environment while the country continues to develop.



Having talked long and hard with my family, we have finally decided that we will go to Costa Rica. I am so excited! I only have 2 months left, and in the meantime, Pura Vida!
