In his raised right hand, he held a bar of antibacterial soap from the bathroom. His older sister Andrea was trying to watch television, but Tommy was impossible to ignore.

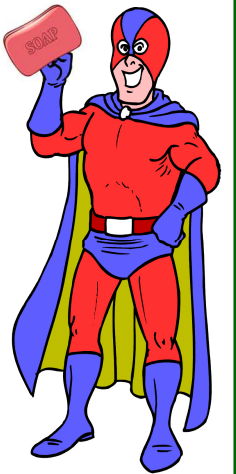
“What in the world are you doing?” she asked him.
