Two months later, they landed their ships on the shores of the Bahamas. They had traveled many miles across the ocean.

Columbus is considered a great explorer. The United States Congress even made a federal holiday to honor his spirit of adventure, his courage, and his accomplishments. In 1971, they declared the second Monday of October each year to be Christopher Columbus Day.
