

Dough Knots



Melanie's older sister Jenny likes to cook and bake. She frequently tries new recipes. Sometimes, she lets Melanie help. Today, they are attempting to make homemade pretzels. They have to mix the dough, roll it into thick strings, fold the dough in a crossover pattern to make the pretzels, and last, bake the pretzels until they turn golden brown.

After the dough is ready, Melanie washes her hands well and takes a ball from the bowl. She places it on a floured sheet of waxed paper then starts to flatten and roll it, just as Jenny has taught her to do. Finally, Melanie has a dough string about as thick as her finger and eight inches long. She shows it to Jenny.
