The DISCOVER THE INTRUDER card game is ideal for practicing vocabulary in pairs or in teams.

The game requires players to know a wide variety of vocabulary and use their creativity, so it has great educational value.

- General information
- Objective: Find out which word is different from the rest of the words given.
- Players: Pairs or groups.
- Language: English.

- It can be played in pairs or in groups, preferably no more than 5 people per group.
- Each letter contains several words among which there is one that does not correspond to the others.
- The time is programmed into the watch. Depending on the age or abilities of the students, they are given 1, 2 or 3 minutes. The less time, the more difficult it will be to solve the test.
- The player takes one of the cards that are in a pile in the center of the table. You will need to find out which word is unrelated to the other words on the card. If the answer is correct, they will score a point on the pad. If you don't guess, it will return the card to the pile in the center of the table.
The different word can be identified because it is of another color, size, shape, type of object, use of the object ... etc.

EXAMPLE HOW TO GUESS THE DIFFERENT WORD - THE INTRUDER
Let's suppose that the card you take is the following


- PLAYER
- AMATEURS
- GOAL
- ANTENNA
- REFEREE

First, read each of the words carefully.
If they all have something in common, you must decide what might make one of the words different from the other four.

For example, in this case all the words except ANTENNA are related to each other because they are all about the same sport, soccer.
