Volunteer firefighters must also be mentioned. They perform their work without getting any kind of compensation. They, usually, help the neediest without expecting a salary. They are people with big hearts.

Firefighters work in buildings called fire stations. Fire stations are distributed throughout the city, to be able to serve all places equally. Firefighters train and prepare the equipment for any emergency at the fire stations. They park the fire trucks there. The fire trucks should be



ready for any circumstance. The trucks are equipped with all the materials and tools needed to help citizens. To drive a fire truck, you must get a special driver's license and be able to drive carefully; since, sometimes, they must move very fast through the streets.

If you want to be a firefighter, you should know that it requires tough preparation. You must be in very good physical shape. This requires hard training in different physical activities, such as climbing up a rope using only your hands, swimming up to 100 meters, or running 2 or

3 kilometers within a specific time. In addition, you must be educated. You

must pass difficult subjects, such as, physics, chemistry, mathematics, as well as other subjects. Finally, firefighters must pass a series of psychological tests and have good social skills. Is it an easy profession?

If you are ever in an emergency, remember that you should call 911. This number is not the same in all countries. For example, in Spain the emergency number is 112, in Colombia it is 119 and in Argentina it is 100. Remember to stay calm and do not lose your temper. The more detailed information you give the better and the easier the rescue
