# December Vocabulary



## Christmas



**Christmas Tree** — tree, usually a pine tree, decorated with ornaments



**Christmas Wreath** — arrangement of leaves or flowers in shape of a ring



**sleigh** — sled pulled horses or reindeer



**Santa Claus** — brings gifts during Christmas to children who have been good

## Kwanzaa



**Mkeka** — Mat made of straw or cloth with symbols of Kwanzaa



**Kikimbe Cha Umoja** — Unity cup: people drink from the cup to honor their ancestors



**kinara** — candle holder for Kwanzaa celebration symbolizes corn stalks



**Muhindi** — One ear of corn for each child still at home placed in a Kwanzaa display

## Hanukkah



**Torah** — Jewish holy book, first five books of the Bible



**Star of David** — star with six points that is a symbol of the Jewish people



**dreidel** — a four sided top used to play a game during Hanukkah



**menorah** — a candlestick holder with nine candles used during Hanukkah celebrations

## Winter



**snow** — precipitation in the form of small white ice crystals



**snowman** — figure made out of snow during winter



**cold** — low temperature: occurs in winter in the northern hemisphere



**ice skates** — special shoes with metal runners for gliding over ice
