Forces make objects move. In fact, they can make objects begin to move, move faster or slower, change direction or stop. These forces can also break objects or change their shape.

There are forces that require contact with objects and can be applied in two ways: by pushing or pulling. So for example, a shopping cart moves when we push it and a toy with wheels moves when we pull it.
