- ☐ I refuse to eat brussel sprouts again.



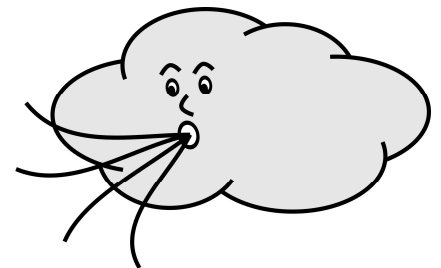
3. The students need to use **lead** pencils for the test.
