

Earth

Earth is the third planet in the Solar System and home to mankind. Earth is the only planet that has life. More than 70% of the planet is covered by liquid water.



The Earth has a moderate climate, with the lowest temperature ever recorded of -130° F and the highest temperature of 140° F. However, humans and their activities are causing major changes in Earth's climate. It is believed that the temperature on Earth will increase by 4° C over the next 50 years.

Earth has a population of more than 7 billion people, spread over 5 continents. The highest mountain on Earth is Mount Everest, which is nearly 29,000 feet above sea level. The lowest point on Earth is the Mariana Trench at a depth of almost 7 miles below the surface of the ocean.
