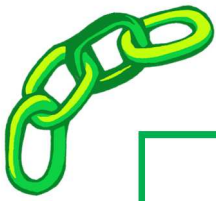

A verb that links the subject with a word that describes it.

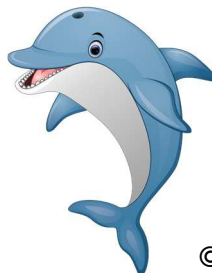
They are not action words.
